This is outrageous as the Liberals seem to be more concerned with votes rather than a sensible and transparent plan for housing and development within our district.


One such site is for 160 new homes to be built on Killingdown Farm.

I will oppose unsustainable development and I will fight to protect our green belt and green spaces.




Rupert Barnes will fight against the urbanisation of Little Green Lane.

PROTECT OUR GREEN SPACES

The Red Cross Centre will be lost unless the Parish Council is allowed to take it on. The land is owned by the District Council, the Parish is ready, so why is TRDC delaying? I will press for progress to restore the facility for the community.

our plan for Three Rivers

1 SAVE OUR GREEN BELT
The Lib Dems' mismanagement of the Local Plan jeopardises our green belt, gives developers an advantage over the destiny of our district and removes joined-up thinking on planning.

Deliver a Local Plan that works for our community with the right homes in the right places. No Watford-style tall towers.
